

**TOWN OF BLACKSTONE  
RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
January 21, 2025**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Moderator Daniel Doyle, who declared a quorum. There were 53 registered voters in attendance.

A motion was duly made and seconded to dispense with the reading of the warrant for the Special Town Meeting.

**ARTICLE 1.** Upon a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted that the Town transfer from Stabilization the sum of \$56,161 to complete funding of the first fiscal year of the collective bargaining agreement between the Town and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, State Council #93, Local #1709B, Town DPW Unit for the fiscal year commencing July 1, a 2024.


