

**TOWN OF BLACKSTONE
RESULTS OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 26, 2020**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Moderator Mark N. Poirier, who declared a quorum.

A motion was duly made and seconded to dispense with the reading of the warrant for the Special Town Meeting.

UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

A motion was duly made and seconded to waive Chapter 5, Section 8, of the Town Bylaws to allow the following nonresidents to participate in discussion at the Annual Town Meeting: Patrick J. Costello, Esq., Louison, Costello, Condon & Pfaff LLP; Lauren Taylor, Town Accountant; Patricia Salamone, Assistant Assessor; Lisa Cheever, Library Director; Gregory Gilmore, Chief of Police; Dr. Michael F. Fitzpatrick, Superintendent-Director, Blackstone Valley Vocational Regional School District; Dr. Jason DeFalco, Superintendent of Schools, Blackstone-Millville Regional School District; and Colleen Strapponi, Health Agent.

UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

A motion was duly made and seconded to take all votes requiring a two-thirds majority in the same manner as when a majority vote is required (as permitted by G. L. Ch. 39, Section 15, as amended by Acts of 1996, Ch. 448, Section 2).

UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

ARTICLE 1 Upon a motion made and duly seconded, it was voted that the Town appropriate and transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$327.79 to pay prior year bill for Zoning Board of Appeals to The Call.

UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

ARTICLE 2 Upon a motion made and duly seconded, it was voted that the Town appropriate and transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$364.05 to pay prior year bill to MHQ.

UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

ARTICLE 3 Upon a motion made and duly seconded, it was voted that the Town appropriate and transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$33.95 to pay prior year bill to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Unemployment Assistance.

UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE


ARTICLE 4 Upon a motion made and duly seconded, it was voted that the Town appropriate and transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$25,874.75 to balance the deficit of the snow and ice account.

UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE

ARTICLE 5 Upon a motion made and duly seconded, it was voted that the Town appropriate and transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$40,000 to pay vocational tuition and transportation.

On a motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to dissolve the warrant and to adjourn the Special Town Meeting at 7:07 p.m. There were 82 voters who attended the meeting.
